Upon approval, the subsidy starts the 1st of the following month.



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

SolVan provides a subsidy of up to \$400 per month (\$500 for zero-emission vehicles) to vanpools that meet the following requirements:

- Each route starts, ends or travels through the Coachella Valley/Blythe areas.
- The commute is to work and/or school.
- There's a 25-mile minimum round-trip.
- Vehicles must be leased by one of SolVan's authorized vanpool vendors.
- 70% of seats are occupied.



WHAT IS A VANPOOL?

If "vanpool" is a new word to you, you're about to discover an exciting way of commuting which will save you money and give you time to focus on things like work, studies and social media by eliminating time at the wheel! Or, if you choose to be a driver – there are other benefits you can enjoy.

A vanpool is a group of 5 to 15 commuters who share a ride to and from work or to school (a vocational/post-secondary educational facility). Drivers are selected out of the group, and can use this vehicle for their own personal use for a limited number of miles. The commuters share the cost of the service, or their employer may subsidize all or part of the cost. Vans leased from a SolVan-qualified leasing vendor range from 7 to 15-passenger vehicles.



SAFETY PROTOCOLS

In compliance with the Transportation Security Administration's directive that masks be worn on all forms of public transportation, SolVan maintain protocols to minimize the spread of COVID-19 by requiring face coverings in all vanpool vehicles as well as social distancing by requiring a seat be empty between riders. Touch surfaces are cleaned regularly, and all vanpools are air ventilated.
